Planning:

Sketch Plan Review for Antelope Run- Mike Roberts

- engineering report, shows all grade and how much water run off
- set up for retention ponds
- 1 change from original sketch, road coming off 29½ with large cul-de-sac and room for Emergency responders, now changed to two access points leading in/1 out
- also purchased additional 10 acres, needs approval to divide into 2-5 acre lots
- loop for utilities, water lines on Royal Dr. will run parallel down 29½ to utility box
- site maps show house and septic locations, allows for setbacks
- Mayor Moon, we will forward to our engineer for review, next opportunity for Board to vote will be Regular Meeting on October 20, 2022

- a. Technology, Business Development- Trustee Smith:
 - gov site for Town
 - computer servers
 - network for Town and PD secure
 - refresh Town and PD machines
- b. Public Works, Water- Trustee Kaus:
 - Air compressor, commercial mowers, roller, skid steer, etc.
 - Seasonal Employee, and uniform allowance
 - Prioritize list
- c. Parks & Recreation, Library- Trustee Kelly:
 - improve Kitchen; stove/oven and fridge, power required
 - create a plan and estimated costs
 - Grants available for Parks
 - Resurface basketball court, Redo covered area in Park and increase size

- d. Finance, Budget, Grants- Trustee Frederiksen:
 - meet with Megan to review what she learned from Grant writing class
 - check with DOLA
 - submitted our names to State for water/waste treatment funds, requested
 - \$8million just for waste, they requested additional information by 9/28
 - water resource very dependent on North Weld, we reported estimate of our potential growth
 - Water committee to meet regularly to be more productive

- e. Code Enforcement/Emergency Planning- Trustee Cable:
 - additional long gun
 - non lethal equipment
 - shields
 - evaluate lease on Tahoe, payoff and/or purchase another vehicle

- f. Senior Outreach/Facilities- Trustee Amen:
 - Trustee Amen absent
 - 10k for Cemetery budget, grants for memorial
